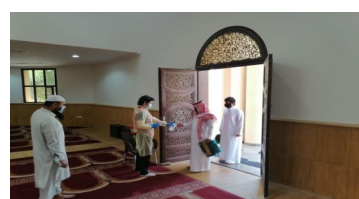

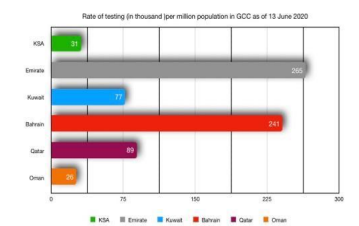

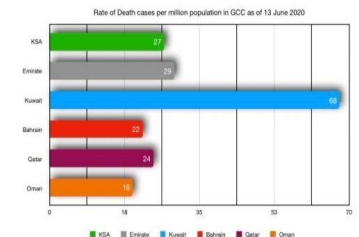
The number of tests (in thousands) per million population in GCC.
